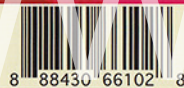

In 2014, the biggest event in world football will return to its spiritual home. Sixty-four years after it first hosted a FIFA World Cup™, Brazil will once again stage the showpiece event. The largest country in South America, Brazil stretches over almost half of the continent and has roughly 190 million inhabitants, making it the fifth most popular country on Earth. The country is divided into five regions (Centre-West, North, Northeast, South and Southeast), which are themselves divided into 26 states plus the Federal District that houses Brazilian capital Brasília.



THE 2014 FIFA WORLD CUP™



The 2014 FIFA World Cup™ host cities are located across the country's five regions, with each scheduled to stage at least four games. Participating teams, members of the media and fans travelling to Brazil will all discover an abundance of flavours, sounds and customs in one of the most culturally diverse nations on the planet. On the following pages, you'll learn more about the 12 cities chosen to host the 2014 FIFA World Cup™.





SÃO PAULO

The financial and business hub of Brazil, not only is São Paulo the biggest city in the country, it also ranks among the most populous in the world, with just over 11 million inhabitants within its area of 1523 square kilometers. Located in the south-eastern region of the country, it is nicknamed Terra da Garoa (Land of the Drizzle) after its renowned weather instability and plentiful rainfall. São Paulo is the very

birthplace of Brazilian football, as it was the home of Charles Miller, the British descendent who presented the beautiful game to the city in 1894 and helped its swift propagation throughout the country. The Arena de São Paulo has been chosen to host the Opening Match of Brazil 2014 and will also welcome five other encounters, including one semi-final.



CURITIBA

The city of Curitiba is one of the finest examples of a bulky economic and industrial development carried out with responsibility and organisation. Since 1853, the city has gone through several major urban planning projects to avoid uncontrolled growth and thus has become an international role model in dealing with such sensitive issues as transportation and the environment. Curitiba is

now the most populous city in southern Brazil, with 1.8m inhabitants, and stands right at the centre of a metropolitan area whose economy ranks fourth in terms of contribution to the country's gross national product. Ever since its renovation in 1999, the historic Arena da Baixada has been considered one of Brazil's most modern stadiums and will host four matches in 2014.



BRASÍLIA

The construction of this ultra-modern city, situated in the centre of Brazil, began in 1956. Since its official foundation on 21 April 1960, the city has served the purpose for which it was built: to replace Rio de Janeiro as the country's capital. Widely considered to be avant-garde city in architectural terms, the Metropolitan Cathedral of Brasília and the Juscelino Kubitschek Bridge are without doubt the most

iconic structures. Both were designed by Oscar Niemeyer, the man behind most of the landmark buildings in the new capital. Due to its architectural feats, Brasília is the only city in the world constructed in the 20th century to have been declared a World Heritage site by UNESCO. **The Estádio Nacional in Brasília will host seven games at the 2014 FIFA World Cup™, including a quarter-final.**



SALVADOR

The first capital city in Brazil's history, Salvador grew under deep influence of Portuguese, Afro-descendants and indigenous alike: a situation that contributed to the cultural richness that typifies the city today. The presence of African elements is all around in Salvador, from the circles of capoeira at the Modelo Market to the beat of the agogôs and atabaques (percussion instruments). The ultimate icon

of the city is the Pelourinho, which is its historical centre: its churches and colourful colonial buildings have been a World Heritage Site by UNESCO since 1985. Salvador will welcome the 2014 FIFA World Cup™ Brazil at a new, purpose-built stadium with a capacity of 52,048. **The new arena will host six games at the tournament and has been constructed on the site of the former Fonte Nova.**



RIO DE JANEIRO

Rio de Janeiro was the seat of Brazilian politics until 1960, when it was replaced by Brasília. Located between a tropical forest and a series of magnificent beaches, Rio is Brazil's most popular tourist destination and cultural hotspot, besides being the country's second most populous metropolis with over 6 million residents. As well as its incomparable natural beauty, Rio's rich history and the

cariocas' contagious joie de vivre have all contributed to making the city known and loved across the globe. Maracanã, arguably the most famous and once the largest stadium in the world, has been completely modernised. It is still the largest stadium in Brazil as a 75,117-seater and will host seven games in all, more than any other venue, including the Final on 13 July.



MANAUS

The very location of the city of Manaus is one of its most remarkable attractions: the confluence of the rivers Negro (Black) and Solimões (named for the Amazon River in this part of Brazil). The dark-coloured waters of the former and the muddy waters of the latter flow side by side for over 18 kms without mixing, forming one of the Amazon's most majestic sights. Manaus is now the 12th most populous

city in Brazil, with just over two million inhabitants and is home to impressive buildings, such as the Amazon Theatre. The equatorial climate of the city is another of its most interesting traits, with an annual temperature average of 28°C, air humidity of over 80%. At Brazil 2014, the Vivaldão, one of the most beautiful stadiums of the competition, will host four matches.



FORTALEZA

Featuring 34 kilometers of wonderful beaches, Fortaleza has been one of the main tourist destinations in the north-east of Brazil for several years. It has also developed into an important economic centre and a densely populated metropolitan area with over 2.4 million people. Most of the tourist attractions in Fortaleza revolve around its beaches: the Praia do Futuro (Future Beach) is popular for its several

barracas - simple kiosk-restaurants - while Iracema is the place for bars and nightclubs. The coastal Beira Mar avenue is also the place for a traditional daily craftsmen's fair and for some of the top spots to dance the forró, a typical rhythm from the north-east of Brazil. Built in 1973 and home to both football teams in the city, the Castelão has been entirely renovated to host matches at Brazil 2014.



PORTO ALEGRE

From the subtropical climate to the cultural habits, Porto Alegre is fairly different from the other state capitals. Founded in 1742, the city was the destination of thousands of immigrants from Portugal, Italy and Germany. The state is located far down the south of Brazil and the gaúchos, as people from Rio Grande do Sul are called, share several cultural traits with their neighbours from Argentina and

Uruguay. Porto Alegre's 497 square kms are covered with more than one million trees, making it one of the greenest cities in Brazil. The city is also famous for featuring one of the highest human development index figures in the country. The beautiful "Giant of Beira-Rio", located in a picture-postcard setting on the banks of the River Guaíba, will host five games at the 2014 FIFA World Cup.



RECIFE

Recife is the capital of the state of Pernambuco, in the north-east of Brazil, and the centre of the country's 4th largest metropolitan area - a conurbation of another 13 cities, including Olinda (declared a World Heritage site by UNESCO in 1982). Because of its economical importance for the region, the city is called 'the capital of the North-east'. For several years, Recife existed essentially as the port that connected

the village of Olinda to the Atlantic. There is no better time to check the traditions of Recife than carnival, when the rhythms of frevo and maracatu completely take the cities over and rock street parades like the Galo da Madrugada, bringing two million people to the streets every year. The city is home to the brand-new Arena Pernambuco, which will host five matches during the games.



NATAL

Since its foundation in 25th December 1599, Natal (Christmas in Portuguese) enjoyed moderate growth until the 20th century, when its innumerable striking beaches and sand dunes were finally surrounded by the proper infrastructure for tourists. The construction of the Via Costeira - a large coastal avenue - in the 1980s was a milestone for the development of Natal. Surrounded by wonders such as Ponta

Hegira, Pipa, Pirangi and several other spectacular beaches within the city and nearby, Natal is proudly known as Cidade do Sol (Sun City) thanks to its faultless tropical climate that provides roughly 300 sunny days a year. Its location, as close to Europe as any other city in the Americas, has also boosted international tourism. The Estádio das Dunas will host four games during the tournament.

BELO HORIZONTE

CUIABÁ

Belo Horizonte - or Beagá, as the city is famously known, after the sound of initials BH in Portuguese - is the sixth-most populous city in Brazil with just over 2.4 million residents, while its metropolitan area comprising a total 34 cities ranks third in the country, behind São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro. From the beauty of its green areas to the careful city-planning: from the wide array of cultural activities to

the nature wonders of the Serra do Curral surrounding it, Belo Horizonte has several reasons for being constantly appointed as one of the Latin American metropolises that provides the best quality of life. One of the most historic stadiums in Brazil, the Mineirão has undergone a complete overhaul prior to hosting six matches at Brazil 2014 - including one semi-final.

Cuiabá is located in the exact geographic centre of South America, an equidistant 2,000 km from the Atlantic and Pacific oceans. Established in 1719 during the Brazilian Gold Rush, its centre still houses several historical buildings that have been declared national heritage sites in 1992. Cuiabá stands on a privileged location for tourists, as it confronts three of Brazil's most important and characteristic ecosystems: the

savannahs of the Cerrado; the wetlands of the Pantanal; and the Amazon. The cuiabanos also neighbour one of Brazil's most startling landscapes: the mountain range of Chapada dos Guimarães. The city is considered the hottest state capital in Brazil, with temperatures over 40°C during summer. Especially built for the 2014 FIFA World Cup™, the Arena Pantanal will host four matches.

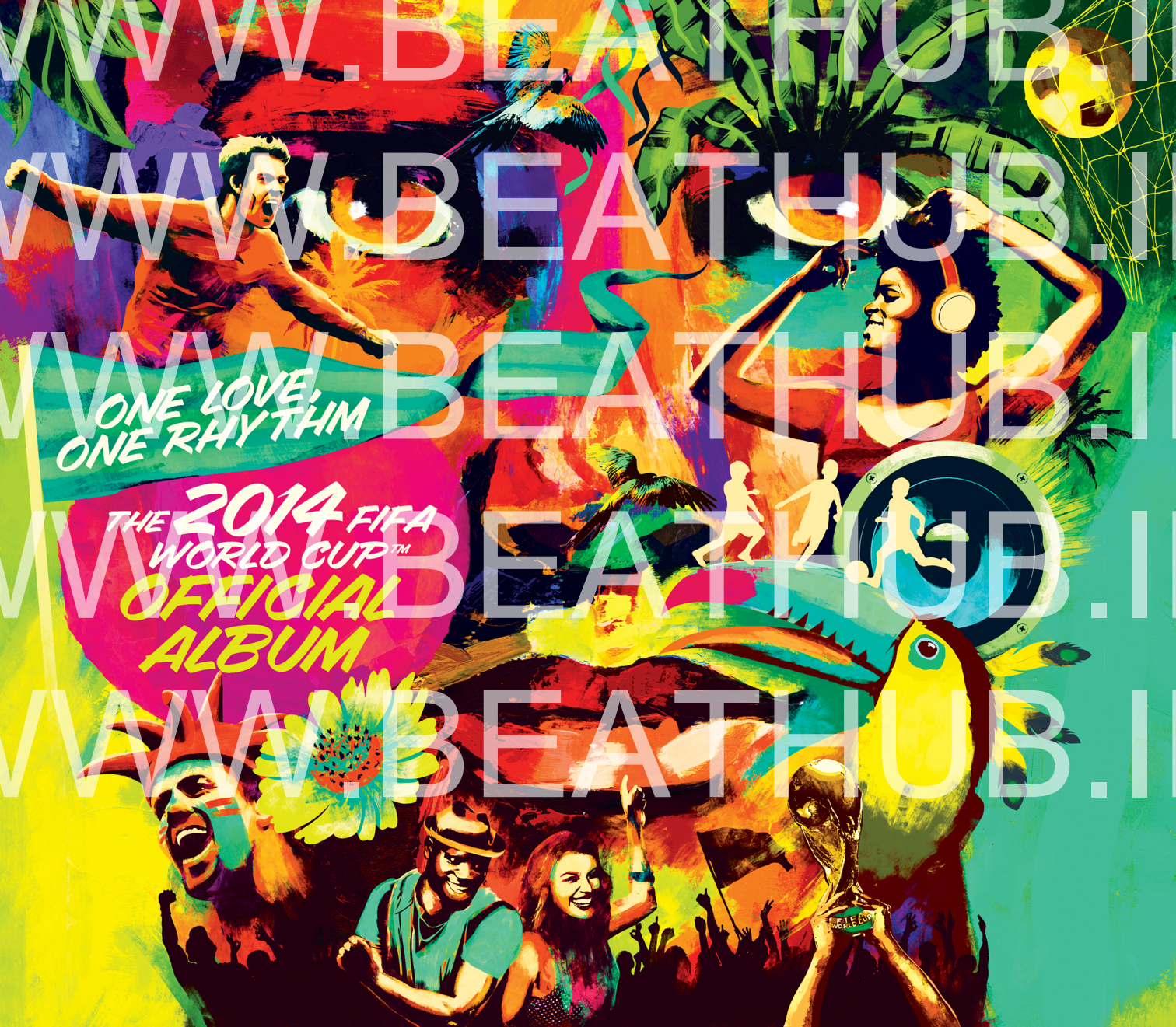
